## **NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE**

### **Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited**

The Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") received an application on October 21, 2009, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited ("Innisfil") charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2010. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2009-0232. The Board's decision on this application may have an effect on all of Innisfil's customers. The application was filed under the Board's guidelines for 3rd Generation Incentive Regulation, which provides for a mechanistic and formulaic adjustment to rates between cost of service applications.

Any change to the rates that Innisfil charges for electricity distribution will be reflected in the delivery charges. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers' electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Innisfil indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 800 kWh per month would experience an approximate 5.9% increase in delivery charges. This is a \$2.78 per month increase on the total bill. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would experience an approximate 2.1% increase in delivery charges. This is a \$1.67 per month increase on the total bill.

### **Interrogatories and Submissions**

Board-approved intervenors who wish information and material from Innisfil that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board and that is relevant to the hearing shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to Innisfil on or before **December 14, 2009**. Innisfil shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to all intervenors no later than **January 8, 2010**.

Written submissions by an intervenor may be filed with the Board, and if so must be delivered to Innisfil and other intervenors, by **January 29, 2010**. If Innisfil wishes to respond to the submissions, its written response must be filed with the Board and delivered to all intervenors by **February 19, 2010**.
