I am writing to respectfully request a 48-hour extension to Wednesday, December 8, 2010 of the deadline for filing CME’s Written Argument in this matter.

I am very sensitive to the Board’s desire to promptly complete the argument phase of this massive case. However, my ability to complete CME’s Argument by December 6, 2010 and to obtain an endorsement from our client has been compromised by my involvement in the motions in the Union Gas proceeding that will be argued in Toronto tomorrow.

Responsibility for drafting CME’s Argument has been allocated between Mr. DeRose, Mr. Hughes and myself. However, the responsibility for consolidating, editing and finalizing the Argument, and obtaining client approval thereof, rests with me.

All three of us are working diligently to complete the task and will be working on it over the weekend.
