Re: EB-2013-0321 – Late Argument from SEP

This letter objects to the late filing of submissions by the Society of Energy Professionals ("SEP") in this matter. OPG was advised on Saturday August 30, 2014 that SEP had filed late submissions with the Board. Apparently the submissions were filed with the Board Secretary late in the afternoon of Friday August 29, 2014. OPG was not served by SEP at that time.

Parties were advised of the schedule for final argument during the course of the proceeding. SEP has had weeks to prepare its argument and to file it on time. Given the number of submissions to which OPG has to reply, the late filing by SEP is prejudicial and unfair to OPG and SEP's submissions should not be accepted by the Board.
