## Ontario Power Generation

### Application to dispose of balances in certain deferral and variance accounts

#### PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2

March 13, 2015

Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on December 18, 2014 under section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for an order or orders related to deferral and variance accounts, including disposition of account balances as at December 31, 2014.

The OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 on February 23, 2015. That procedural order approved intervenor status for ten parties. On March 6, 2015, Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) filed a notice of intervention and applied for cost award eligibility.

The OEB approves Energy Probe as an intervenor provided that Energy Probe accepts the record as it stands. Energy Probe shall file interrogatories by March 16, 2015, but must be prepared to meet all other timelines set out in Procedural Order No. 1.

The OEB has determined that Energy Probe is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. Energy Probe should be aware that the OEB will not generally allow the recovery of costs for the attendance of more than one representative of any party, unless a compelling reason is provided when cost claims are filed.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. Energy Probe shall request any relevant information and documentation from OPG that is in addition to the evidence already filed, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on all parties by **March 16, 2015**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2014-0370**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at [www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/](http://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/). Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at [www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry](http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry). If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
