**Re: EB-2015-0179: Union Community Expansion Application.**

**Pre-Hearing Conference Transcript Correction.**

---

We have reviewed the transcript from today's pre-hearing conference in the captioned matter, and wish to underscore two material corrections required to that transcript.

The first is a correction that should be made at page 40, line 6 of the transcript. There the writer intended to state IGUA's position, though the transcript records the statement as one of Union's position. The reference to "Union" in line 6 should be replaced with one to "IGUA", so that the statement reads:

*"And in respect of EPCOR's evidence, ~~Union~~ IGUA supports expansion. It opposes subsidies through rates on a policy basis, it's our understanding that EPCOR's evidence will at least in part seek to address the economics of Union's proposals..."*

The second is a less consequential (from our perspective) correction, but one required to render the subject statement meaningful as intended. At page 38, line 25 of the transcript, again the reference to "Union" should be replaced with reference to "Enbridge", so that the statement reads:

*"... in respect of Enbridge's evidence, IGUA is very interested, having read Enbridge's letter, in information on costs to existing ratepayers, be they Union ratepayers or fairly soon proposals in respect of costs to ~~Union's~~ Enbridge's ratepayers."*

To the extent that these errors were misstatements on the writer's part, or resulted from talking too fast, I apologize.
