**Re: Certificate of Compliance in Relation to Licence ER-2011-0253
EB-2010-0405**

I am writing in respect of the Certificate of Compliance filed by Canada Energy Wholesalers Ltd. (Canada Energy) on March 2, 2016 for the purposes of the condition of Canada Energy's licence as described in section 4 of Ontario Regulation 90/99 (Licence Requirements – Electricity Retailers and Gas Marketers) and section 6.2 of the Electricity Retailer Code of Conduct.

On January 14, 2011, Canada Energy filed with the OEB a Certificate of Compliance under section 6.1 of the Electricity Retailer Code of Conduct in which Canada Energy indicated "no" or "N/A" in relation to one or more statements. The Certificate of Compliance that you filed on March 2, 2016 indicates that Canada Energy now intends to conduct the following retailing activities in respect of low volume consumers as of March 2, 2016: Door-to-Door.

Peter Fraser has, under delegated authority, completed the OEB's review of your most recent Certificate of Compliance, and this letter acknowledges that the Certificate of Compliance has been completed and signed in accordance with the requirements of the Electricity Retailer Code of Conduct. This acknowledgement is provided for the sole purposes of section 6.2 of the Electricity Retailer Code of Conduct and section 4 of Ontario Regulation 90/99, and pertains exclusively to the form, content and signature of

your most recent Certificate of Compliance. It does not in any way constitute acknowledgement by the OEB of Canada Energy's actual compliance with any or all applicable legal and regulatory requirements.

In the Certificate of Compliance that you filed on January 14, 2011, you indicated that Canada Energy was not conducting certain other retailing activities in respect of low volume consumers which are not addressed in your most recent Certificate of Compliance; specifically: Exhibitions, Trade Shows, and Telephone Renewals. You are reminded that Canada Energy may not conduct these retailing activities in respect of low volume consumers until such time as you have filed with the OEB a further Certificate of Compliance as required by section 6.2 of the Electricity Retailer Code of Conduct and have received from the OEB written acknowledgement of it.

The acknowledgement set out in this letter is given effective August 19, 2016. This letter, together with your Certificate of Compliance, will be available for viewing at the OEB's offices and will be placed on the OEB's website.
