Union Gas Limited

Application for approval to construct a natural gas pipeline in the Township of Dawn Euphemia, the Township of St. Clair and the Municipality of Chatham-Kent and approval to recover the costs of the pipeline

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 4

November 25, 2016

Union Gas Limited (Union) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on June 10, 2016 for:

1. leave to construct 40 kilometres of 36 inch diameter pipeline from Union's Dawn Compressor Station in the Township of Dawn-Euphemia to its Dover Transmission Station in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent (the Project) pursuant to section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B (Act)
2. approval of the recovery of costs associated with the construction of the Project pursuant to section 36 of the Act
3. approval to calculate the Project's revenue requirement and resulting rates based on a 20 year depreciation term
4. approval of an accounting order to establish a Panhandle Reinforcement Deferral Account pursuant to section 36 of the Act

On November 22 and 23, 2016 the OEB, in an oral hearing in Toronto, heard all issues other than the landowner issues¹. This procedural order will set the schedule for completion of record on issues covered in the oral hearing. The procedural steps

include: Union's written argument-in-chief, written submissions by intervenors and OEB staff and reply submission by Union.

The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Union shall file with the OEB written argument-in-chief and deliver it to all the intervenors by **November 30, 2016**.
2. Intervenors and OEB staff shall file written submissions with the OEB and delivered to Union and other intervenors by **December 14, 2016**.
3. Union shall file written reply submissions with the OEB and deliver it to all intervenors by **December 30, 2016**.

All filings to the OEB must quote file number **EB-2016-0186**, be made through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format.

Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the BoardSec@ontarioenergyboard.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file seven paper copies. If you have submitted through the OEB's web portal an e-mail is not required.
