## Order

Ingredion Canada Corporation filed an application on January 26, 2017 with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB), under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) to amend its electricity generation licence EG-2002-0266. The requested amendment is to change the name that appears on the licence and to amend Schedule 1 of the licence.

The current name on licence EG-2001-0017 is Ingredion Canada Incorporated. The applicant requested a name change from Ingredion Canada Incorporated to Ingredion Canada Corporation to reflect a change in the legal name of the licensee that occurred as a result of the amalgamation of Ingredion Canada Incorporated with Ingredion Nova Transition Corporation. Ingredion Canada Corporation is an entity resulting from the amalgamation. The applicant provided a Certificate of Amalgamation issued under the Canada Business Corporations Act to support the name change.

The amendment to Schedule 1 is required to reflect the sale of a natural gas fueled co-generation facility, located in Port Colborne, to another party licensed by the OEB, and the addition of a new 15 MW co-generation facility located in Cardinal, Ontario. The new facility will be owned and operated by the applicant.

I have considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

### **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

Schedule 1 of electricity generation licence EG-2001-0017 is amended. The amended licence is attached to this Order.
