**Subject: EB-2015-0179 – Re-Application of Intervenor Status**

Pursuant to Procedural Order 6, dated April 7th, 2017, Northeast Midstream LP (“Northeast”) wishes to re-apply for intervenor status in the above-mentioned proceeding.

In addition to this hearing, Northeast is an intervenor in Epcor’s Southern Bruce Project (EB-2016-0137 et. al.) and was an intervenor in the Generic Proceeding (EB-2016-0004). Our continued interest in this family of proceedings is to help ensure that expansion of natural gas service in Ontario will be a fair, reasonable, and economically feasible process.

Our reasons for re-applying for intervenor status in EB-2015-0179 are the same as our reasons for participating in EB-2016-0137 et. al. That is: Consequential rules and orders will directly affect future Board proceedings and will impact the viability of future expansions, including our project to serve Marathon, Schreiber, Terrace Bay, Wawa, and Manitouwadge.
