Application for electricity distribution rates and other charges beginning July 1, 2017

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 May 26, 2017

InnPower Corporation (InnPower) filed an amended cost of service application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on May 11, 2017 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that InnPower charges for electricity distribution, to be effective July 1, 2017.

The OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1 on May 16, 2017, which provided for the filing of interrogatories and responses.

The OEB has determined that further Notice of this application is required for specific customer groups in respect of specific services charges that InnPower has proposed to increase. As a result, additional procedural dates are being provided for interrogatories related to specific service charges, including the rate for pole attachments. The dates for interrogatories and responses on other matters remain unchanged.

It is necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Further procedural orders may be issued by the OEB.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. InnPower shall arrange for the service of this Procedural Order and of each of the approved English and French versions of the Notice, and the application and the evidence, directly on any specifically identifiable customers or customer groups that would be directly impacted by one or more of the proposed changes

to specific services charges, including, but not limited to, any entities that currently pay a charge for access to InnPower's power poles, as well as microFIT and net metering customers.

2. Any intervention request received by noon on **June 5, 2017** (12:00 pm) will not be considered as a late intervention request. The OEB will issue a procedural order on June 5, 2017 if additional intervenors are approved.
3. The schedule for filing interrogatories and responses as specified in Procedural Order No. 1 remains unchanged for all matters except for specific service charges.
4. OEB staff and intervenors may request any relevant information and documentation from InnPower related to specific service charges, by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and served on all parties by **June 13, 2017**.
5. InnPower shall file with the OEB complete written responses to the interrogatories related to specific service charges by **June 30, 2017**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2016-0085**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.oeb.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Registrar at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
