Enbridge's application states that a "typical consumer" would see an annual increase rate of \$5.74, but being an atypical consumer (since, living by myself and spending most of my week at work, my monthly bill is pretty low), I already saw a Cost adjustment charge of \$0.83, not to mention a note for Gas cost adjustment of \$0.6269, either of which would amount to more than \$5.74 stated by Enbridge and, I can't stress this enough, my monthly bill is quite low compared to any of my friends or neighbors. I can understand that Enbridge might need to increase its gas charge rates, but setting unrealistic expectations as to how this increase would impact their customers seems dishonest to me.
