Independent Electricity System Operator / Smart Metering Entity

Application for approval of smart metering charge for 2018-2022

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2 November 22, 2017

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO), in its capacity as the Smart Metering Entity (SME), filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on August 31, 2017 under subsections 78(2.1), (3.0.1), (3.0.2) and (3.0.3) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, seeking approval for its 2018-2022 smart metering charge.

Procedural Order No. 1, issued on October 27, 2017, established a number of procedural steps for this proceeding. The OEB will extend the deadline for OEB staff and intervenors to file interrogatories, and the deadline for the IESO to respond to those interrogatories, by five business days. All other deadlines set out in Procedural Order No. 1 remain the same.

THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. The deadline for OEB staff and intervenors to serve and file written interrogatories is extended by five business days, to **December 4, 2017**.
2. The deadline for the IESO to serve and file responses to the interrogatories is extended to **December 29, 2017**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2017-0290**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal

address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
