The Independent Electricity System Operator (“IESO”) is in receipt of the Ontario Energy Board’s (“OEB”) Notice of Application and is writing to request intervenor status in the above noted proceeding.

The IESO is responsible for maintaining the security and reliability of electricity supply in Ontario and for directing the operations of the IESO-controlled grid. The IESO also has the mandate to ensure the adequacy and efficiency of electricity supply in the province through planning of electricity supply and demand.

The IESO has a direct interest in this application based on its responsibility to direct the operation and maintain the reliability of the IESO-controlled grid. The IESO has provided the recommended scope for the new line to Pickle Lake at Exhibit B-4-1, Appendix D, as well as through System Impact Assessments at Exhibits G-2-2 and G-3-2.
