

**Independent Electricity System Operator, in its capacity as the Smart Metering Entity**

**Application for approval to provide access to certain non-personal data to third parties at market prices**

**PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2**

**April 10, 2019**

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO), in its capacity as the Smart Metering Entity, filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on December 4, 2018 under sections 74 and 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* seeking approval to amend its licence to enable it to provide access to certain non-personal data about electricity usage to third parties at market prices.

On January 25, 2019, the OEB issued Procedural Order No. 1, which made provision for a Settlement Conference. On March 28, 2019, the IESO notified the OEB that a settlement was not reached on any of the issues. Procedural Order No. 1 invited submissions from the parties on which issues could be heard in writing, and for which issues the OEB should hold an oral hearing, in the event the settlement conference did not result in a settlement proposal.

No parties to the proceeding requested that the OEB hold an oral hearing.

The OEB will therefore proceed with a written hearing. The deadlines for written submissions are set out below.

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**THE ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD ORDERS THAT:**

1. The IESO shall file its Argument-in-Chief with the OEB and serve on all other parties by **April 18, 2019**.
2. Intervenors and OEB staff shall file any written submissions with the OEB and serve on all other parties by **May 3, 2019**.
3. The IESO shall file any reply submission with the OEB and serve on all other parties by **May 17, 2019**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2018-0316**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.oeb.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
