DECISION AND ORDER

Elliot Cogeneration Inc. filed a complete application on January 10, 2020 under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (OEB Act) for an electricity generation licence.

Elliot Cogeneration Inc. will own and operate a 9.996 MW combined heat and power generation facility, known as Elliot Cogeneration. The facility will be operating under a Combined Heat and Power Standard Offer Program 2 contract with the Independent Electricity System Operator.

This Decision and Order is being issued by the Delegated Authority, pursuant to Section 6 of the OEB Act. The Delegated Authority has considered the application without holding a hearing pursuant to section 6(4) of the OEB Act.

After considering the application and assessing technical capability and financial viability of the applicant, the OEB finds that it is in the public interest to grant the application and issue the electricity generation licence to Elliot Cogeneration Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
