NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE

Orangeville Hydro Limited And Grand Valley Energy Inc

The Ontario Energy Board received two applications on November 7, 2008 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15 (Schedule B), seeking approval for harmonization of and changes to the rates that Orangeville Hydro Limited (“Orangeville”) and Grand Valley Energy Inc. (“Grand Valley”) charge for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2009. The Board has assigned the application file numbers EB-2008-0204 and EB-2008-0177, respectively. The Board’s decision on this application may have an effect on all of Orangeville’s and Grand Valley’s customers. The applications were filed under the Board’s guidelines for 2nd Generation Incentive Regulation, which provides for a mechanistic and formulaic adjustment to rates between cost of service applications.

Any change to the rates that Orangeville and Grand Valley charges for electricity distribution will be reflected in the delivery charges. Delivery charges are one of four regular items on residential and general service customers’ electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed.

Orangeville indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 4.3% increase in their delivery charges. This is a \$1.64 increase per month on their bill. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50

kW or lower would experience an approximate 2.9% increase in their delivery charges. This is a \$1.88 increase per month on their bill.

Grand Valley indicates that if the application is approved as filed, a residential customer consuming 1,000 kWh per month would experience an approximate 4.2% increase in their delivery charges. This is a \$1.58 increase per month on their bill. A small general service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of 50 kW or lower would experience an approximate 3.5% increase in their delivery charges. This is a \$2.23 increase per month on their bill.

How to see Orangeville's and/or Grand Valley's Application

Copies of the application are available for inspection at the Board's office in Toronto and on its website, www.oeb.gov.on.ca, and at Orangeville's office and may be on its website.

How to Participate in the Rate Proceeding

The Board intends to proceed with Orangeville's and Grand Valley's rate change applications by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for holding an oral hearing. If you object to a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any objections to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant at the addresses below no later than December 12, 2008. The Board will not be awarding costs in this matter.

Anyone who wishes information and material from the applicant that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to the applicant on or before January 5, 2009. The applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to all parties who asked interrogatories no later than January 19, 2009.

Anyone who wishes to make a submission on the application must file that written submission with the Board and deliver it to the applicant by February 2, 2009. If the applicant wishes to respond to the submission(s), the written response must be filed

with the Board and delivered to all parties who made submissions by February 17, 2009.
