Today the Board has issued an Amended Decision and Cost Order, EB-2007-0050 (the Amended Decision).

In the original Decision and Cost Order, the Board decided to award SON all consulting and legal fees costs claimed, except for the consulting costs that were not supported by time-dockets. On page 7 of its decision the Board explained:

The Board will award all of the legal and consulting fees appropriately claimed by the SON in this proceeding. Not all hours claimed for consulting fees were supported by the time dockets as required by Board's Practice Directions on Cost Awards, and therefore these costs will not be awarded. The total amount of legal and consulting fees that is appropriately supported by time dockets is \$ 519,117.00 and this amount is allowed to be awarded.

SON sent a supplemental (corrected) cost claim to the Board on October 9, 2008 (the Supplemental Claim), which included time dockets for 64.4 hours which had not originally been supported by time dockets.

The Supplemental Claim consists of:

1. A revised Form 3 in Support for the Stage Two Claim

Revised Total Cost Claim of \$ 193,303.82 (an increase of \$14,710.50 over the original Stage Two Claim). The change is due to revised additional 64.4 hours for consulting fees. There is no increase in disbursements claimed for Stage Two.

- 2. Revised Form 1 Summary Statements for consultants W. Russell, G. Looker and T. Besich of Whitfield Russell Associates.
- 3. Supporting time dockets.

On October 29, 2008, Hydro One put on the record via e-mail that it had no comments on the Supplemental Claim.

Review of the supporting time dockets indicates that all the 64.4 hours claimed in the Supplemental Claim are now appropriately supported and described in the time dockets. The Board concludes that SON's Supplemental Claim is in accordance with the *Practice Directions on Cost Award*.

The Board has decided to award to SON costs in the amount of \$14,710.50 and has amended it Original Decision accordingly.
