RE: Enbridge Gas Distribution (EGD) - 2009 IRM Rates, Phase II (EB-2008-0219) - Proceeding Schedule

We are counsel to the Association of Power Producers of Ontario (APPrO) in the above-noted proceeding. We are writing on behalf of APPrO to express support for the request, made by the Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA) in its letter of January 30, 2009, for a change in the schedule for this proceeding.

Specifically, IGUA proposes that the Board adjust the hearing schedule to allow for EGD responses to intervenor interrogatories on EGD's Phase II evidence to be completed prior to the filing of intervenor evidence. Consistent with the conventional approach to hearing scheduling, this will enable intervenors to consider the additional information contained in the interrogatory responses prior to determining whether to file evidence and, if so, what evidence to file. APPrO strongly supports this requested change and the proposed timetable set out in the IGUA letter.
