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## **ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD**

IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O.1998, c.15 (Sched. B)

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Bluewater Power Distribution Corporation for an Order or Orders pursuant to section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for 2009 distribution rates and related matters.

## APPLICATION

- The Applicant is Bluewater Power Distribution Corporation ("Bluewater Power"). Bluewater Power is a licensed electricity distributor operating pursuant to license ED-2002-0517. Bluewater Power distributes electricity to approximately 35,000 customers in the municipalities of the City of Sarnia, the Town of Petrolia, the Village of Point Edward, the Village of Oil Springs, the Township of Warwick and the Township of Brooke-Alvinston in south-western Ontario.
- Bluewater Power hereby applies to the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") for an order or orders made pursuant to Section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998,* as amended, (the "OEB Act") approving just and reasonable rates for the distribution of electricity based on a 2009 test year.
- 3. Specifically, Bluewater Power hereby applies for an order or orders granting approval of:
  - a. its forecasted 2009 service revenue requirement of \$21,436,076, \$21,320,229,
    which leads to a base distribution revenue requirement of \$20,707,479,
    \$20,591,632, net of other revenue;
  - b. distribution rates that allow Bluewater Power to recover its forecasted 2009 distribution revenue requirement, effective May 1, 2009;

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- c. specific distribution service charges;
- d. the disposition of certain deferral and variance account principal balances as at December 31, 2007 along with the carrying charges projected to April 30, 2009;
- e. Bluewater Power's current distribution rates becoming interim commencing May 1, 2009 until Bluewater Power's proposed distribution rates are approved and implemented; and
- f. Recovery of amounts related to a Lost Revenue Adjustment Mechanism ("LRAM"), and Shared Savings Mechanism ("SSM").
- g. <u>Authorization to use a deferral account to record the net distribution margin realized</u> by Bluewater Power for power supplied to Royal Polymers Ltd. and UBE Automotive North America Sarnia Plant, Inc. (as per the update to the pre-filed evidence dated February 2, 2009).
- 4. As indicated by Bluewater Power's pre-filed evidence, Bluewater Power's 2009 total service revenue requirement is forecasted to be \$21,436,076, \$21,320,229 and base revenue requirement is forecasted to be \$20,707,479 \$20,591,632. Based on current distribution rates and forecasted load, Bluewater Power forecasts a 2009 revenue deficiency of \$4,843,712 \$5,087,340.

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5. The 2009 distribution rates proposed by Bluewater Power will result in overall monthly bill impacts as follows:
