Appendix A

Sample Letter to the LTLT Customer Proposed to be Transferred to PowerStream Inc.

YOUR ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTOR MAY BE CHANGING

Dear customer:

Your electricity distributor, Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. with the consent of its neighbouring distributor, PowerStream Inc. filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board requesting changes to both distributors' electricity distribution service areas. If the application is approved, you will become a customer of PowerStream Inc. You are not required to take any action in response to this letter but you may wish to let the Ontario Energy Board know of any concerns you may have about the application.

As you know, you are currently a customer of Hydro One Brampton and charged Hydro One Brampton's rates for electricity distribution services. However, you may not know that your electricity is physically supplied by PowerStream Inc. You are within Hydro One Brampton's service area but are actually served electricity by PowerStream Inc. This arrangement is known as a long term load transfer.

The Ontario Energy Board requires geographic electricity distributors (in your case, Hydro One Brampton) to eliminate long term load transfer arrangements. One option available to distributors to meet this requirement is to permanently transfer the load transfer customers to the electricity distributor that physically supplies them (in your case, PowerStream Inc.).

To eliminate the load transfer arrangement between Hydro One Brampton and PowerStream Inc., Hydro One Brampton with the consent of PowerStream Inc. filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board for an order approving changes to both distributors' distribution service areas in order to transfer you to PowerStream Inc.'s service area. If the Board approves the application, you will become a customer of PowerStream Inc.; you will be supplied and served by PowerStream Inc. and will be charged PowerStream Inc.'s distribution rates which are higher than Hydro One Brampton's distribution rates.

Based on your prior year's consumption, the proposed transfer will result in an estimated increase of (\$) on your total monthly electricity bill which represents an impact

of (%) on your total bill.
