We are counsel to the Consumers Council of Canada (the "Council").

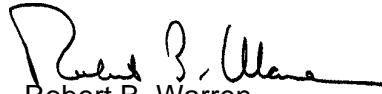
We have been instructed by our client to intervene in the application of Greater Sudbury Hydro Inc. seeking approval for changes to its distribution rates. The Council is a non-profit, public interest entity, representing the interests of residential consumers of electricity in Ontario, including consumers in Greater Sudbury Hydro Inc.'s distribution area. The application, if approved, will have a direct impact on the rates paid by residential consumers of electricity. Greater Sudbury Hydro Inc. indicates that the application, if approved, would result in increases in the delivery charge for residential consumers.

The Council intends to seek an order, at the conclusion of the proceeding, for its costs. The Council has participated in many applications, by both electricity and gas distribution companies, seeking approval of rates. In all of those applications, the Council has been found to be eligible for an award of costs.
