IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Peterborough Distribution Inc. for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2009.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 3

Peterborough Distribution Inc. (Peterborough Dist. or the Applicant) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, received on October 10, 2008, under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, (the Act), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Peterborough Dist. charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2009. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2008-0241.

The Board issued Procedural Order No. 2 on February 17, 2009 in which it established the dates for a Technical Conference, the filing of clarification questions by intervenors and Board staff and the responses to these questions by the Applicant.

The Board has determined that these dates should be revised.

Please be aware that this Procedural Order may be amended, and further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. A Technical Conference will be convened on Tuesday March 31, 2009, at the Board's offices at 2300 Yonge Street in the North Hearing Room on the 25th floor starting at 9:30 a.m.
2. Prior to the Technical Conference, intervenors or Board staff who wish to ask clarification questions that relate specifically to the existing interrogatory responses shall file them with the Board and deliver a copy to the Applicant on or before Friday March 6, 2009. These matters will form the basis for the Technical Conference. In

order to ensure an efficient Technical Conference, Peterborough Dist. will provide written responses by Friday March 27, 2009.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number EB-2008-0241, be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable/unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.oeb.gov.on.ca. If the web portal is not available, you may email your document to the Board through BoardSec@oeb.gov.on.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD or diskette in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
