Union Gas Limited Notice of Application Leave to Sell NPS 24 Natural Gas Pipeline

St. Clair Pipelines L.P. ("St. Clair") is a Spectra Energy Corp partnership and is in receipt of the Notice of Application and Hearing delivered by Union Gas Limited on February 12, 2009. St. Clair Pipelines Management Inc. is the general partner of St. Clair and, on behalf of St. Clair, submits this request for intervenor status in the noted proceeding.

St. Clair owns and operates NEB-regulated natural gas assets in Lambton County, including the Bluewater Pipeline and 873 metres of NPS 24 pipeline from the St. Clair Valve Site to the International Boundary ("St. Clair River Crossing"). The St. Clair River Crossing is directly connected to the 11.7 kilometres of NPS 24 pipeline referenced in the noted proceeding and is proposed to be part of the Dawn Gateway Line. St. Clair has an interest in matters that may affect its assets, including transportation to and from Dawn.

- St. Clair does not have a preference with respect to an oral or written hearing and does not intend to seek an award of costs for its participation in this proceeding.
- St. Clair reserves its right to participate in all aspects of the noted proceeding, including evidence, interrogatories, cross-examination and argument.
