**Re: Ontario Power Authority  
2009 Expenditure and Revenue Requirement Submission  
Ontario Energy Board File No. EB-2008-0312**

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The Ontario Power Authority ("OPA") is writing to file a revision to its 2009 Revenue Requirement Submission (the "Submission") with the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB"). The original application requested approval to charge registration fees of \$10,000 per proposal for electricity supply and capacity competitive procurements. This revision requests approval to charge registration fees of up to \$10,000 for electricity supply and capacity procurements.

The flexibility requested will allow the OPA to establish an appropriate registration fee for the feed-in-tariff ("FIT") program through the transparent consultation process it will be running to develop FIT rules. This work is being undertaken to prepare for the launch of the FIT program if Bill 150 is passed by the legislature.

There is no change to the OPA's 2009 registration fee budget as originally submitted. All other aspects of the OPA's original submission remain unchanged.
