ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD

IN THE MATTER OF the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S/O, C.15, Schedule B; and in particular sections 36.1(1), 38(1) and 40(1) thereof.

AND IN THE MATTER OF for an order of the Ontario Energy Board approving the parties to, the period of, and the cost-based storage that is the subject of a T1 Gas Storage and Distribution Contract (the "T1 Contract") with Ferrous Processing and Trading Company ("Ferrous") acting as fuel manager for Soave Hydroponics Company located in Kingsville Ontario.

INTERVENTION OF ENBRIDGE GAS DISTRIBUTION INC.

- 1. Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge" or the "Company") hereby applies for intervenor status in this proceeding pursuant to the above-captioned matters.
- 2. Enbridge is a distributor and transmitter of natural gas in Ontario. The supply of natural gas is a vital concern to the Company and its customers.
- 3. Enbridge has a direct interest in all matters of jurisdiction, substance, and procedure in the regulation of public utilities, and in any decision of the Ontario Energy Board ("Board"), which may create a precedent affecting the Company's own applications.
- 4. Enbridge purchases certain storage and transportation services from Union Gas Limited ("Union") pursuant to rate schedules approved by the Board.
- 5. At this time, it is the intention of Enbridge to monitor this proceeding, however; after reviewing the evidence, Enbridge may address one or more of the issues.
- 6. Enbridge reserves it right to fully participate as an intervenor in this proceeding and should the Board decide to proceed by way of an oral proceeding, Enbridge reserves the rights to appear by or with counsel of its choice, to cross-examine on

all subject matters in this hearing that may relate to its interests, to adduce evidence on specific matters that are relevant to these proceedings, and to present argument.
