### Submission of Natural Resource Gas Limited ("NRG")

Gas Franchise Approval and Approval to Establish a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the City of London (Board File Nos.: EB-2009-0067 and EB-2009-0068)

NRG has reviewed both NRG and Union's existing Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity for the former Townships of Westminster and North Dorchester. This involved comparing the Certificates granted to Union by the Board in an Order dated March 17, 1959 (Exhibit "A") with those granted to NRG in an Order dated May 5, 1982 (Exhibit "B").

Union's Certificate essentially states that they cover the whole of the municipality except for those areas listed in an attached Schedule, while NRG's Certificate covers only the specific lots listed. Thus, the Certificates should not encroach on one another (i.e., what is listed on NRG's Certificate should be listed on Union's Certificate as an exempted area). However, after reviewing the Certificates, it appears as if the Certificates do not entirely operate in this manner.

There are a few discrepancies that we wish to draw to the Board's attention. The fact that the Certificates do not match up precisely is not surprising considering the age of the Certificates and the evolution of gas service in the area. For both Westminster and North Dorchester, we have set out four headings:

- Heading A (<u>Portions that are on NRG's Certificates and Excluded from Union's Certificates</u>): Under this heading is listed all of the properties that "work" correctly on the existing Certificates. In other words, they appear on NRG's Certificate and appear as an excluded area on Union's Certificate. There is no conflict between these provisions.
- Heading B (<u>Portions that are on NRG's Certificates But Not In Union's Certificates</u>): Under this heading is listed all of the properties that appear on NRG's Certificate but do not, for some reason, appear in Union's Certificate as exemptions. These should probably appear on Union's New Certificate as exempted properties. If the plan is for Union's Certificate to simply say "all areas not under Certificate to NRG", then there is no need to spell these out specifically.
- Heading C (Portions that are Exempt from Union's Certificates But Not In NRG's Certificates): There are two possible explanations for these properties: (1) The properties listed under this heading have been exempted from Union but are not areas under Certificate to NRG. This could mean that these properties are unclaimed, and granting Union a Certificate for "all areas not under Certificate to NRG" would grant these areas to Union. The description suggests these areas do not make up a huge chunk of land, but NRG would like to learn the location of these properties; (2) The other explanation is that these are "old concessions" (note that they are "lettered" concessions, not numerical concessions), which could very well mean that they have been renumbered and are in fact covered off correctly.
- Heading D (<u>Unclear</u>): These Certificates were confusing as the wording leaves it up to interpretation whether the properties conflict with one another.

Using these four headings, our comparison yielded the following:

# Conclusion

As noted, Union has already received these comments and we are working with Union to examine the potential discrepancies (particularly under Heading C). Once that is done, NRG will be able to provide its position on the application.

It is NRG's intention to review these sorts of applications in municipalities that are "shared" by Union and NRG to: (a) ensure that NRG does not passively cede un-Certified areas that are adjacent to NRG's current assets; and (b) ensure that the existing Certificates of utilities are accurate.
