Re: LEAP Implementation Working Groups

I am counsel to the Consumers Council of Canada (the "Council"). On May 20, 2009, the Ontario Energy Board ("Board") advised stakeholders that it intended to form two working groups to assist the Board with the implementation of its Low-income Energy Assistance Program ("LEAP"). The Board is seeking nominations for working groups to provide that assistance.

The Council is a non-profit, public interest group which represents the broad array of residential consumers of natural gas and electricity.
