**ONTARIO ENERGY BOARD**

**IN THE MATTER OF** the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S/O, C.15, Schedule B; and in particular sections 38(1) and 40(1) thereof.

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** for an order of the Ontario Energy Board approving the parties to increase the operating pressures in four natural gas storage pools – Bentpath East Pool, Oil City Pool and Bluewater Pool (the “Pools”) – above the pressures set in the Board’s original conditions of approval. The Pools are located in the City of Sarnia and Townships of Enniskillen and Dawn-Euphemia, in the County of Lambton.

**INTERVENTION OF ENBRIDGE GAS DISTRIBUTION INC.**

1. Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (“Enbridge” or the “Company”) hereby applies for intervenor status in this proceeding pursuant to the above-captioned matters.
2. Enbridge is a distributor and transmitter of natural gas in Ontario. The supply of natural gas is a vital concern to the Company and its customers.
3. Enbridge has a direct interest in all matters of jurisdiction, substance, and procedure in the regulation of public utilities, and in any decision of the Ontario Energy Board (“Board”), which may create a precedent affecting the Company's own applications.
4. Enbridge purchases certain storage and transportation services from Union Gas Limited (“Union”) pursuant to rate schedules approved by the Board.
5. Enbridge reserves its right to fully participate as an intervenor in this proceeding and should the Board decide to proceed by way of an oral proceeding, Enbridge reserves the rights to appear by or with counsel of its choice, to cross-examine on all subject matters in this hearing that may relate to its interests, to adduce evidence on specific matters that are relevant to these proceedings, and to present argument.


