DECISION AND ORDER

Olameter Inc. filed an application dated April 23, 2009 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the “Act”) for a smart sub-metering licence.

The Board’s Notice of Application and Written Hearing for a smart sub-metering licence was published on May 15, 2009. No parties responded to the Notice of Application and Written Hearing.

Section 3.1 of the standard smart sub-metering licence authorizes the licensee to “...engage in the commercial offering or the commercial provision of smart sub-metering systems, equipment and technology and any associated equipment, systems and technologies and any associated services for the prescribed class of property.” Licensees must register with Measurement Canada if the licensee undertakes activities prescribed by section 6(2) of the *Electricity and Gas Inspection Act*.

The applicant is not registered with Measurement Canada. However, the applicant has indicated that, at this time, it only intends to provide smart sub-meter reading, billing and call centre services. The applicant has acknowledged that it will comply with Measurement Canada registration requirements before undertaking any activity that requires such registration.

After considering the application, I find it to be in the public interest to issue the smart sub-metering licence under Part V of the Act.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The application for a smart sub-metering licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
