NOTICE OF APPLICATION

UNION GAS LIMITED

LEAVE TO CONSTRUCT FIVE (5) KILOMETERS OF PIPELINE AND ANCILLARY FACILITIES TO MEET THE NATURAL GAS SERVICE REQUIREMENTS OF THE EAST WINDSOR COGENERATION CENTRE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WINDSOR, COUNTY OF WINDSOR-ESSEX

Union Gas Limited (the "Applicant" or "Union") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, (the "Board") dated August 14, 2007, under section 90(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B. Union has applied for an order of the Board for leave to construct approximately five kilometers of 12 inch Nominal Size Pipe ("NPS") pipeline in the city of Windsor to meet the natural gas service requirement of the East Windsor Cogeneration Centre. The proposed facilities are located in the Township of Windsor, in the County of Windsor-Essex.

The Board has assigned File No. EB-2007-0708 to this Application.

The proposed 12 inch NPS pipeline connects Union's existing Panhandle system to the East Windsor Cogeneration Centre site ("the proposed station"), and runs southerly from the proposed station site east of Walker Road to the Windsor Ford Line Station Take Off site, south of the Daimler Chrysler Plant. A map showing the location of the proposed pipelines is included as appendix "A" in this Notice.

How to see the Applicant's Pre-filed Evidence

Copies of the application and the pre-filed evidence in support of the application will be available for public inspection at the Board's offices and at Union Gas Limited's head office.

How to Participate

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

You may send the Board a letter of comment. Your letter may include a request to make an oral presentation to the Board, and must be received by the Board no later than **30 days** from the publication date of this notice.

You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter received by the Board no later than **10 days** from the publication date of this notice.

You may request intervenor status if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter of intervention received no later than **10 days** from the publication date of this notice, or, if you have been served this notice personally, no later than **10 days** from the date of service. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the proceeding; and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may choose to hold either a written or an oral hearing. Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.

Map showing the location of the proposed pipelines and wells

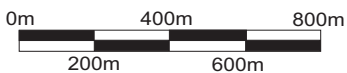
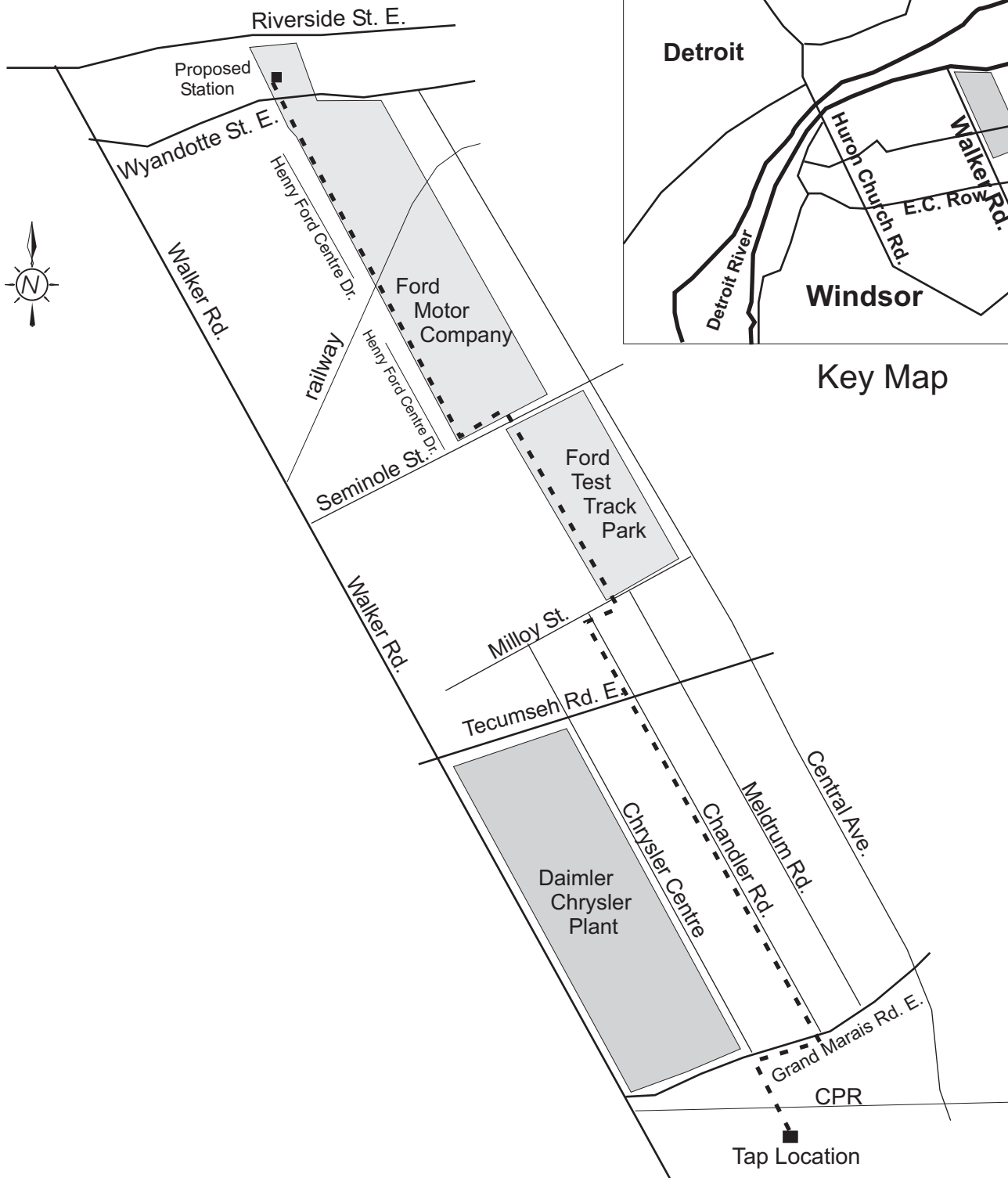
