IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Union Gas Limited for approval of its 2010 Natural Gas Demand Side Management Plan.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

Union Gas Limited ("Union" or "the Applicant") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board"), received on June 1, 2009, under the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B for an order granting approval of its 2010 Natural Gas Demand Side Management ("DSM") Plan.

Notice of Application was served as directed by the Board.

As a result of the Notice of Application being served Consumers Council of Canada ("CCC"), Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters ("CME"), Energy Probe, The Green Energy Coalition ("GEC"), Industrial Gas Users Association ("IGUA"), Low Income Energy Network ("LIEN"), the London Property Management Association ("LPMA") and Pollution Probe requested intervenor status and requested eligibility for an award of costs. Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") and the City of Kitchener requested intervenor status but will not be seeking an award of costs. Subject to Union's right to object, the Board grants the intervention requests and costs eligibility to CCC, CME, Energy Probe, GEC, IGUA, LIEN, LPMA and Pollution Probe and intervention requests to Enbridge and the City of Kitchener.

The Board has determined that it is necessary to make the following provisions related to this proceeding:

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

 Intervenors and Board Staff who wish information and material from the Applicant that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board, and delivered to the Applicant on or before, Thursday, July 30, 2009.

All interrogatories and responses must include a reference to the section of the application which identifies the specific evidence on which the interrogatory is based.

- 2. The Applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the intervenors and observer no later than **Thursday**, **August 6**, **2009**.
- Any party that wishes to comment on Union's application or interrogatory responses shall do so by written submissions filed with the Board, and delivered to Union, on or before Thursday, August 13, 2009.
- 4. Union may respond by written submission filed with the Board, and delivered to all parties, on or before Thursday, August 20, 2009.
