Letter of Intervention of the Consumers Council of Canada (the "CCC")

We are counsel to the CCC.

We have been instructed by our client to advise you that it wishes to intervene in the above-captioned application of Enersource Hydro Mississauga for an increase in its distribution rates, to be effective January 1, 2010.

The Council is a non-profit, public interest entity, representing the interests of residential consumers of electricity in Ontario, including ratepayers in Enersource's distribution area. The outcome of the application will have a direct impact on residential consumers of electricity.

The Council intends to seek an order, at the conclusion of the proceeding, for its costs.

Based on what we know of the application, we believe it can be disposed of without an oral hearing component. If the information elicited in the discovery phase of the process suggests that an oral hearing is required, we will so notify the Board, Enersource, and all parties.
