Application for Order Varying Conditions of Approval

This letter is to inform the Board of a change in Union’s evidence in the above project.

As stated in Paragraph 16 of the evidence, Union completed an assessment of all the pipelines and wells in the various Pools to determine if they were in compliance with all Codes and Standards. During the review of facilities in the Oil City Pool as described at Paragraph 37 of the pre filed evidence it was determined that the observation well on the Cascaden property would require upgrading. After a technical review of the facilities in the Oil City Pool, and discussions with the Cascaden’s, it was determined the preferred alternative was to abandon the well on the Cascaden property rather that upgrade the Observation Well.

There were two observation wells in the Oil City Pool. Union will be able to monitor pressure from the remaining observation well if the Cascaden well is abandoned.

The observation well on the Cascaden property was abandoned in August 2009, according to Ministry of Natural Resources requirements and CSA code Z341.
