We are counsel to the Consumers Council of Canada (the "CCC").

By this letter we are requesting that our client be made an intervenor in the application of Horizon Utilities Corporation ("Horizon") for approval of the recovery of certain amounts related to an unforeseen loss of revenue.

The CCC represents the interests of the broad array of residential consumers of electricity within the service territory of Horizon. The granting of the application will have an impact on the rates paid by those residential consumers. In addition, the application raises important points of regulatory and public policy. The decision of the Board on those policy matters will set a precedent for the way other utilities deal with losses of revenue due to changes in operations of large-use customers. It is, therefore, essential that the interests of residential consumers be represented.

The CCC is a public-interest, non-profit entity which has no revenues of its own to support its intervention. The CCC will, therefore, seek an award of costs at the end of the proceeding.
