IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S. O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application for an Order granting leave to construct new transmission lines and facilities for Greenwich Windfarm LP.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

An application dated August 11, 2009 (the "Application") has been filed by Greenwich Windfarm LP (the "Applicant" or "Greenwich") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") under section 92(1) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B, seeking an Order of the Board granting leave to construct transmission facilities. The Application has been assigned Board File No. EB-2009-0315.

The Applicant is seeking leave to construct transmission facilities for the Greenwich Windfarm. The project involves constructing a substation at the Windfarm site, approximately 10.3 kilometres of 230 kV double circuit electricity transmission line, and a switching station to connect the Windfarm to two 230 kV Hydro One owned transmission lines (M23L and M24L).

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Written Hearing on September 17, 2009. The Applicant has served and published the Notice as directed by the Board. One application was received from the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) for intervention in this proceeding. The Board approves the IESO as an intervenor subject to the Applicant's right of reply to that request within 10 days of the issuance of this procedural order. No application for observer status was received.

A list containing addresses of the Applicant and Intervenor is attached as Appendix A to this procedural order.

In the Notice of Application and Hearing, the Board indicated that it intended to proceed by way of a written hearing unless any party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not proceeding by way of a written hearing. No party has made such a request and the matter will proceed by way of a written hearing. If the proceeding does not encounter unusual circumstances, it is expected that a decision would be rendered on or about December 19, 2009.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following items related to the Application. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Board staff and intervenor(s) who wish information from the Applicant that is in addition to the evidence pre-filed with the Board and that is relevant to the hearing shall request the information by means of written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to the Applicant on or before **Friday, October 16, 2009**.
2. All interrogatories and responses must include a reference to the section of the application which identifies the specific evidence on which the interrogatory is based.
3. The Applicant shall, no later than **Monday, October 26, 2009** file with the Board and deliver to Board staff, a complete response to each of the interrogatories.
4. Intervenors and Board staff shall provide the Applicant, and file with the Board, any submission they wishes to make no later than **Friday, October 30, 2009**.
5. The Applicant shall provide its reply to any submissions by intervenors or Board staff no later than **Friday, November 6, 2009**.
6. All filings to the Board noted in this Procedural Order must be in the form of 2 hard copies and **must be received by the Board by 4:45 p.m. on the stated dates**. An electronic copy of the filing must also be provided. If you already have a user ID, the electronic copy of your filing should be submitted through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca. If you do not have a user ID, please visit the "e-Filing Services" page on the Board's website at

www.oeb.gov.on.ca and fill out a user ID password request.
