RE: Hydro One Networks Inc.'s Connection Procedures
Motion to Review and Vary (EB-2007-0797)

We are counsel to the Electricity Distributors Association (the "EDA").

Further to the Board's Notice of Hearing and Procedural Order No. 1 issued on October 26, 2007, please be advised that the EDA intends to participate in this proceeding. A copy of this letter is being delivered to all parties identified in Appendix B to the Notice.

In its Procedural Order, the Board also indicated that all intervenors that were eligible for costs in Hydro One's EB-2007-0501 transmission rates case, other than the EDA, would be eligible for costs in this proceeding as well.

In EB-2007-0501, the Board determined that the EDA would be eligible for costs on the basis that the EDA represented the interests of customers in relation to transmission. That continues to be the case in relation to the issues raised in the Motion to Review and the EDA respectfully requests that it be found eligible for costs in this proceeding. The EDA represents a distinct group of transmission customers whose interests are not otherwise represented before the Board.
