**Re: Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited's ("THESL")  
2010 Electricity Distribution Rate Application  
OEB File No. EB-2009-0139**

THESL has received interrogatories by November 13, 2009 from the following intervenors: Building Owners and Managers Association of the Greater Toronto Area, Consumers Council of Canada, Pollution Probe, School Energy Coalition ("SEC"), Smart Sub-Metering Working Group, and Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition. On November 16, 2009, THESL received interrogatories from the Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario ("AMPCO") and Energy Probe Research Foundation ("Energy Probe"). THESL has not received any interrogatories from the Canadian Union of Public Employees, Local 1 or the Ontario Power Authority.

THESL has reviewed the interrogatories received and observes that SEC has not presented their interrogatories in the manner prescribed by the Board in Procedural Order 2. Consequently THESL is unable to readily associate SEC interrogatories with the relevant

issue on the Approved Final Issues List and will await SEC's revised interrogatories before proceeding to answer them. THESL will do its best to answer SEC interrogatories in a timely fashion once received in the prescribed format but anticipates there may be a corresponding delay and requests an extension with respect to SEC's interrogatories equivalent to the delay THESL is subject to in receiving them. In addition, THESL has also just received Energy Probe's and AMPCO's interrogatories this morning. Given the delays associated with AMPCO and Energy Probe's interrogatories, THESL requests a two-day extension to submit its responses to those interrogatories.
