IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Orangeville Hydro Limited for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2010.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 2

Orangeville Hydro Limited (Orangeville Hydro) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, received on August 28, 2009 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, seeking approval for changes to the rates that Orangeville charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2010. The Board has assigned File Number EB-2009-0272 to this application.

In Procedural Order No.1, issued on October 7, 2009, the Board made provision for written interrogatories. The two registered intervenors, the School Energy Coalition ("SEC") and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC"), and Board staff filed interrogatories, and Orangeville Hydro filed responses to the interrogatories on November 6, 2009. In that procedural order the Board noted that after review of the responses to the interrogatories it would determine the next steps including the provision for a second round of interrogatories.

This Procedural Order No.2 provides for supplemental interrogatories. After receipt of the responses, the Board will determine the next steps through another procedural order.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- Intervenors or Board staff who wish to ask questions that relate to the interrogatory responses filed by Orangeville Hydro on November 6, 2009 shall file written interrogatories with the Board and deliver a copy to the Applicant no later than **November 30, 2009.** The questions should reference the response already provided and the pre-filed evidence where possible.
- 2. Orangeville Hydro shall file with the Board complete responses to the supplemental interrogatories and deliver them to the intervenors no later than **December 30, 2009.**

All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2009-0272, be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.oeb.gov.on.ca. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the BoardSec@oeb.gov.on.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file seven paper copies. If you have submitted through the Board's web portal an e-mail is not required."
