**NOTICE OF APPLICATION

**GAS FRANCHISE APPROVAL AND APPROVAL TO ESTABLISH  
A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY  
FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF CRAMAHE**

Union Gas Limited (the “Applicant”) has filed an application dated October 22, 2009 with the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) under section 9 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended (the “Act”). The Applicant has applied for an order of the Board approving the terms and conditions upon which and the period for which the Corporation of the Township of Cramahe (the “Corporation”) is, by by-law, to grant to the Applicant the right to construct and operate works for the distribution of gas and the right to extend and add to the works in the Township of Cramahe (the “Municipality”). The Applicant has also applied for an order of the Board declaring and directing that the assent of the municipal electors to the by-law is not necessary.

On January 1, 2001, the former Township of Cramahe and the former Village of Colborne were amalgamated to form the Township of Cramahe by Minister’s Order.

The Applicant has applied, pursuant to section 8 of the Act, for an order of the Board cancelling the existing Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate”) associated with the former municipalities within Township of Cramahe and replacing them with a Certificate for the amalgamated Corporation of the Township of Cramahe.

The Applicant currently holds franchise agreements associated with the former Township of Cramahe and the former Village of Colborne. The Applicant currently holds

The application will be decided by the Manager, Natural Gas Applications, who has been delegated this authority pursuant to section 6 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). The Manager, Natural Gas Applications does not intend to provide for an award of costs when deciding this application.

Copies of the application and pre-filed evidence will be available for public inspection at the Board's offices, the Applicant's offices, and at the office of the Corporation at the addresses indicated below.

The Board intends to proceed with the application by way of a written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is a good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to the Board holding a written hearing in this matter, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board within **7 days** of the publication date of this Notice.

If you wish to participate in the written hearing, you must make a written submission that is received by the Board no later than **14 days** after the publication date of this Notice, with a copy to the Applicant, at the addresses below. If the Applicant wishes to respond to the written submissions, such response must be received by the Board no later than **21 days** after the publication date of this Notice. All submissions must be received by the Board Secretary by **4:45 p.m.** on the required dates.

All filings to the Board must quote file numbers EB-2009-0378 and EB-2009-0379, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format filed through the Board's web portal at [www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca](http://www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca). Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number and, if available, a fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found on the "e-Filing Services" webpage of the Board's website at [www.oeb.gov.on.ca](http://www.oeb.gov.on.ca). Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD or diskette in PDF format, along with two paper copies.
