The services that CanSIA believes are provided at little or no cost by certain Ontario distributors and BC Hydro include:

- Meter Locates for installing electricians
- Occasional site meetings to determine meter locate
- Issuing hand-drawn sketches of required changes to service entrance for connection
- Installation of meters
- Administrative fees

Question Three

Further please specify which of these services are provided at no cost and which services are provided at little cost. In the latter case please also provide the cost.

Response

It is CanSIA's understanding that the majority of these services are provided at no cost with the exception of administrative fees that approximately total \$15 / month.

Question Four

Please also indicate whether it is the intent of these entities to provide these services at little or no cost on a permanent basis or as a transitional measure.

Response

It is CanSIA's understanding that Enersource offered to perform these services at no or low cost initially and may move to a pay for service structure in time. CanSIA is not aware of the intent of the other utilities to provide these services on a permanent basis or as a transitional measure.
