Customer Care's planning assumption is for 130 FIT contracts annually (per 11 Interrogatory Response Exhibit H, Tab 1, Schedule 54). This estimate is based on an 12 average number of FIT contracts over the business planning period assumed at the outset 13 of the business planning process in late 2008. This assumption was subsequently updated 14 for the purpose of planning the investments required to connect renewable generation, as 15 summarized in Exhibit D1, Tab 3, Schedule 3. However, the revised FIT contract 16 numbers were not used to update Customer Care's investment needs. Hydro One 17 recognizes that this means the Customer Care costs requested in its Application may be 18 lower than what is likely to be required in the test years. 19

Customer Care's planning also assumed 3,600 microFIT contracts annually (per 21 Interrogatory Response Exhibit H, Tab 1, Schedule 54). This planning estimate was 22 based on information relayed by the Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure and Ontario 23 Power Authority when announcing the Green Energy and Green Economy Act. There 24 was an expectation of 100,000 Solar microFIT contracts over 5 years in the Province of 25 Ontario, and Hydro One estimated 25% of these would be in our territory. Based on these 26 assumptions the business plan was established to support 300 connections a month with 27 some scalability to support higher numbers should they materialize. 28
