IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act 1998*, S.O.1998, c.15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. for an Order or Orders approving or fixing just and reasonable rates and other charges for the sale, distribution, transmission and storage of gas commencing January 1, 2010.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 3

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge" or the "Applicant") filed an Application on September 1, 2009 (as amended on September 14, 2009) with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") under section 36 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. c.15, Sched. B, as amended, for an order of the Board approving or fixing rates for the distribution, transmission and storage of natural gas, effective January 1, 2010. The Board assigned file number EB-2009-0172 to the Application and has issued a Notice of Application dated September 18, 2009 (the "Notice").

The Application is for rates for 2010 to be set under the Incentive Regulation plan methodology as approved by the Board under File No. EB-2007-0615. 2010 will be the third year of the five year plan. The rates under the plan are adjusted each year by the application of a Distribution Revenue Requirement per Customer Formula (the "Adjustment Formula"). The Applicant's evidence was filed on October 1, 2009.

Procedural Orders Nos. 1 and 2 dealt with a Preliminary Motion in which the Board sought and heard jurisdictional arguments on Enbridge's proposed Green Energy Initiatives. The Board held a hearing on the matter on November 24, 2009 and issued its Decision on December 22, 2009.

The Board will now make provision for the following procedural matters. A Case Timetable is attached as Appendix "A". A Draft Issues List is attached as Appendix "B".

Please be aware that further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The approved List of Intervenors is attached as Appendix "C" to this procedural order.
- 2. All parties, including Enbridge, wishing to make a submission on the Draft Issues List attached to this Order may do so on or before **January 8**, **2009**.
- 3. Enbridge may reply to any submission on the Draft Issues List by **January 13**, **2010**.
- 4. Enbridge may, at its option, file updated evidence by **January 22, 2010**.
- 5. Parties seeking information and material on Enbridge's evidence shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to all the parties no later than **January 26, 2010**.
- 6. Enbridge shall file complete responses to all the interrogatories with the Board and deliver the responses to the other parties no later than **February 9, 2010**.
- 7. A Technical Conference shall be convened on February 11, 2010 so that the Applicant and parties may respond to questions related to the filed evidence. The Technical Conference may proceed on February 12, 2010 if required. The Technical Conference will be transcribed and will be held in the Board's hearing room at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto at 9:30 a.m.
- 8. Enbridge and the other parties will respond to any undertakings given at the Technical Conference on or before **February 17, 2010**.
- 9. A Settlement Conference will be convened at 9:00 a.m. on **February 22, 2010** with the objective of reaching a settlement among the parties on the issues.

The Settlement Conference will be held in the Board's hearing room at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto, and may continue until **February 24, 2010** if needed.

- 10. Any Settlement Proposal arising from the Settlement Conference shall be filed with the Board no later than 4:45 p.m. on **March 1, 2010**.
- 11. The oral hearing will commence on **March 4, 2010** at 9:30 a.m. The hearing may proceed on **March 5, 8, 9** and **11**, if needed.

All parties shall file their submissions with the Board Secretary and must quote file number EB-2009-0172. These submissions should be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.oeb.gov.on.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address and must be sent to the Board by 4:45 pm on the date indicated with a copy to all parties. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.oeb.gov.on.ca. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the addresses below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD or diskette in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies. - 7. Is the amount proposed for the Y factor DSM Program appropriate?
- 8. Is the amount proposed for the Y factor for Gas in Storage and related carrying costs appropriate?
