RE: EB-2007-0050 - Hydro One Networks' Section 92 Bruce to Milton Transmission Reinforcement Application

This is to acknowledge receipt of Hydro One's Notice of Amended Application regarding the matter noted above. Please accept this correspondence as a letter of intervention from The Regional Municipality of Halton (the "Region").

A portion of the lands that will be affected by the potential local route changes are located in Halton Region. Among other things, the Region is responsible for long range environmental planning within its borders. Any potential route realignment for the Bruce to Milton Transmission Reinforcement Project must take into consideration how the natural environment will be affected.
