Dear Mr. Weston

In early 2007, the Fair Power Coalition of wind power developers was established to ensure Ontarians are provided the best opportunities for clean, reliable and cost-effective wind power. Leader Resources Corp. is one of the partners in this very worthy effort.

Right now, there are 400 megawatts of safe, clean and reliable wind power developments ready to be installed throughout the Bruce Peninsula, as far south as Orangeville. There is great potential in this area to develop further projects that will help meet electricity needs for the future. However, our projects are thwarted by the "Orange Zone" restrictions imposed by the Ontario Power Authority.

It is our opinion that Hydro One's plan to expand the transmission corridor stretching from Kincardine to the Milton switching station is absolutely mandatory to the development of wind energy in Ontario.

**Therefore, we are requesting observer status in the Leave to Construct proceedings, application EB-2007-0050, that are scheduled to go before the Ontario Energy Board.**

We recognize the notice was filed March 29, 2007 and the 10-day limitation to request observer status has now passed, but note that we were unaware of the ways in which we could lend our support to the proposed project until a copy of a Notice of Application was hand-delivered to us at a recent Public Information meeting.
