Please be advised that we are solicitors for Mrs. Stephanie Kupiak who has referred your letters to Dmytro Kupiak and Stephanie Kupiak of April 17, 2007 to the writer for comment.

We wish to confirm that Mr. Dmytro Kupiak died on or about June 13, 1995 and the property is now registered solely in the name of Stephanie Kupiak. Document General registering the death certificate on title was registered on November 2, 1995 as Instrument Number 845607.

Our client is objecting to the acquisition or expropriation by Hydro One of the lands referred to in your applications for the following environmental reasons:

1. The proposed tower line will destroy a mature hardwood bush along the entire width of our client's land. There are several spring fed streams and a pond located on Mrs. Kupiak's property. The destruction of the hardwood bush will in all likelihood dry up the streams and the pond. We shall await the further comments of the Hydro One's assessment and report before commenting further on the environmental issues.
