Re: Request for Information


Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) is in receipt of your letter dated March 10, 2008, addressed to R. Watson, Manager, Freedom of Information Office. Your letter included a series of interrogatory questions for OPG and a request that OPG respond to those questions. You also indicate that the interrogatory questions are in relation to EB-2007-0050, which is an application by Hydro One Networks Inc. for an order or orders granting leave to construct a transmission reinforcement project between the Bruce Power facility and the Milton Switching Station.

The Ontario Energy Board's Procedural Order #5 allows for intervenors who would like information and material from the applicant, which is in addition to the written evidence filed by the applicant with the Ontario Energy Board, to request such information from the applicant by written interrogatories filed with the Ontario Energy Board and delivered to the applicant. As an intervenor in this proceeding, OPG has not filed any evidence and is neither required nor expected to respond to any interrogatories.

Further to the reference in your letter to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, OPG agrees with your view that, given the nature of your questions, this legislation does not appear to be relevant.

Accordingly, OPG will not be responding further to your request.
