Re: EB-2009-0425 – Hydro One Networks’ Section 92 – Toronto Midtown Transmission Reinforcement Project – Ontario Energy Board Procedural Order Number One (1) Intervenor Request to Submit Evidence

On February 4, 2010, the Toronto District School Board (the “TDSB”) received a Notice of Application and Hearing regarding Hydro One Networks Inc.’s Application for leave to construct transmission reinforcement facilities in the Toronto Midtown area to reinforce and enhance its existing 115 kilovolt (“kV”) transmission system. In response to the Notice of Application and Hearing, the TDSB made a request to the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) to receive intervenor status.

On February 23, 2010, the TDSB received Procedural Order Number One (1) from the Board; granting the TDSB intervenor status and outlining a series of orders. In response to Procedural Order Number One (1), the TDSB would like to advise the Board of its intention to submit written evidence.
