DECISION AND ORDER

Countryside London Cogeneration Corp. ("Countryside") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (the "Act") for an order of the Board to amend its licence (EB-2007-0775). The application was received by the Board on June 20, 2008. Countryside requested a name change from Countryside London Cogeneration Corp. to Fort Chicago District Energy Ltd.

On June 27, 2008, Countryside also requested that the amended licence reflect both the ownership and operation of the generation facility under the new name of Fort Chicago District Energy Ltd.

The licence amendment is granted. The amended licence number is revised to EG-2007-0775 to reflect the standard numbering system used by the Board.

Background

Countryside is the licensed owner of a 17.2MW cogeneration facility under construction in London, Ontario. The licensed operator of this facility is USE Canada Energy Corp (EG-2003-0119), now known as Countryside District Energy Corp. ("CDEC").

Countryside stated that it is requesting this amendment because the name of the company was changed to Fort Chicago District Energy Ltd. following a reorganization of its parent company and Countryside's merger with, CDEC, an affiliated company. The amalgamation and name change became effective April 1, 2008.

Reasons

The Applicant provided documentation supporting the amalgamation of Countryside and CDEC and the right of the new, amalgamated entity to use the name Fort Chicago District Energy Ltd. There are no other changes to Countryside apart from the change of name following the amalgamation with CDEC and the intent to operate as well as own the subject facility. All other corporate information remains the same.

I have proceeded without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding and the applicant has consented to disposing of the proceeding without a hearing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Countryside London Cogeneration Corp's Electricity Generator Licence EB-2007-0775 is amended to reflect the requested name change and the authorization to own and operate. The amended licence is renumbered as EG-2007-0775. The new licence is attached to this Order.
