### **DECISION AND ORDER**

Canadian Hydro Ltd. ("Canadian Hydro") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") pursuant to sections 52 and 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (the "Act") for an order of the Board to amend its licences. The application was received by the Board on December 11, 2006.

Canadian Hydro requested a name change from Canadian Hydro Ltd. to Canada Energy Wholesalers Ltd.

The licence amendments are granted.

## **Background**

Canadian Hydro stated that it is requesting these amendments due to the existence of an unrelated power generator with a similar name (Canadian Hydro Developers Inc.) that is licenced by the Board. In addition, Canadian Hydro now offers services beyond selling electricity and would like to change their corporate name to reflect the services now offered.

There are no other changes to Canadian Hydro apart from the name change. All other corporate information remains the same.

### **Licence Amendments**

Pursuant to subsection 6(1) of the Act, I have been delegated the powers and duties of the Board with respect to the determination of applications made under sections 52 and 74 of the Act. This order is made under the authority of that delegation and is based on the evidence filed in support of the application.

I have proceeded without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Canadian Hydro Ltd.'s Gas Marketer Licence GM-2006-0204 and Electricity Retailer Licence ER-2006-0184 are amended to reflect the name change. The new licences are attached to this Order.

Under section 7(1) of the Act this decision may be appealed to the Board within 15 days.
