DECISION AND ORDER

Glenridge Gas Utilization Inc. ("Glenridge") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for an order of the Board to amend its electricity generation licence (EG-2004-0440). The application was received by the Board on August 22, 2007.

Background

Glenridge requested that Schedule 1 of its electricity generation licence be amended to include an additional generation facility. The additional generation facility, the East Landfill Generation Project, will be located at 2800 Thorold Townline Road, RR#1, Niagara Falls, Ontario. The East Landfill Generation Project will consist of a single 1 MW generator fueled by landfill gas.

Glenridge's existing generation facility is also a generator fueled by landfill gas. It is located at 541 Glenridge Avenue, St. Catharines, Ontario.

There is no change to any of the other information that Glenridge filed as part of its original licence application.

Pursuant to subsection 6(1) of the Act, I have been delegated the powers and duties of the Board with respect to the determination of applications made under section 74 of the Act. This order is made under the authority of that delegation and is based on the evidence filed in support of the application.

The applicant met all of the Board's requirements for obtaining a licence in 2004 and has the technical and financial capability to own and operate the additional generation facility. Furthermore, the applicant has a Standard Offer Program contract with the Ontario Power Authority in relation to this additional generation facility.

After considering the application, I find that it is in the public interest to amend Schedule 1 of Glenridge's electricity generation licence.

I have proceeded without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no person will be adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of this proceeding and the applicant has consented to disposing of the application without a hearing. While I recognize that a person other than the applicant might have some interest in the location of the generation facility, the choice of location of the generation facility is not within my jurisdiction to determine. The granting of the licence does not mean that the project can proceed without obtaining all other necessary approvals. Therefore, no person will be adversely affected by the outcome of this proceeding (i.e., amending the licence to include the additional generation facility).

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Schedule 1 of Glenridge Gas Utilization Inc.'s Electricity Generation Licence EG-2004-0440 is amended to include the East Landfill Generation Project. The new licence is attached to this Decision and Order.

Under section 7(1) of the Act this decision may be appealed to the Board within 15 days.
